# 3. What happens if I miss the deadline?

Students who miss the deadline must receive permission from the President's Office to participate. Please email the office at <a href="mailto:graduation@concord.edu">graduation@concord.edu</a> or call 304-384-5223 for permission.

## 4. Where do I order my cap and gown?

Your cap and gown were ordered by the bookstore based on your answers from the Intent to Participate Form. Students who requested that their cap and gown be mailed to them will be contacted by the bookstore for postage payment. An email will be sent to all students when the cap and gowns are ready to be picked up.

#### 7. Can tickets be mailed to me?

No, tickets cannot be mailed. If you are unable to pick up your tickets prior to graduation, you may pick them up at the ticket table on the day of your ceremony.

#### 8. Do children need tickets?

Yes. The only exception is for children 5 and under to be able to sit on another of your guests' laps.

## 9. When do I need to arrive at the ceremony?

45 minutes to 1 hour prior to your ceremony

## 10. Do I have to wear my hood for the Masters Ceremony?

No, you will hold your hood as you go up on stage and it will be placed on you.

#### 11. Can I get extra tickets?

Phone and email requests are no longer accepted. Tickets are given out on a first come first serve basis. You may also ask students who are graduating in the same ceremony as you if they have any extra tickets.

No, due to safety regulations, no one other than graduates may cross the stage.
