WHEREAS, International Hotel & Tourism Industry Management School and Concord University recognize a common interest in international education; and

WHEREAS, International Hotel & Tourism Industry Management School and Concord University further desire to cooperate in establishing a continuing education relationship for the benefit of the respective students of each;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual consonances and agreements hereinafter set forth, the parties agree as follows:

- 1) International Hotel & Tourism Industry Management School shall recommend Concord University to its students interested in pursuing studies in the United States and shall make appropriate recommendations to Concord respecting the acceptance of such students. Concord agrees to accept students from International Hotel & Tourism Industry Management School provided that such students are recommended by International Hotel & Tourism Industry Management School, and shall have completed not less than one year of studies at International Hotel & Tourism Industry Management School. Concord agrees to accept the credits earned at International Hotel & Tourism Industry Management School in accordance with the attached course description evaluation.
- 2) International Hotel & Tourism Industry Management School agrees to supply as soon as possible final letter grades and other essential academic records to Concord University, Office of the Registrar, for all International Hotel & Tourism Industry Management School students who transfer to Concord University.
- 3) International Hotel & Tourism Industry Management School students participating in this program shall make all required payments for tuition, room & board, or fees connected with the program directly to Concord University. Such students shall be accorded all the rights and privileges of regular students at Concord University.
- 4) This agreement is effective for five years from the date of signature by the duly authorized representatives of the two institutions. Thereafter, it will be automatically renewed without the need for a new agreement unless either institution proposes termination at least six months prior to the expiration date.
- 5) Either party may terminate this Agreement for convenience by giving thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other Party.



COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into as of the 5th June, 1989 by and between Concord College hereinafter referred to as Concord, and The International Hotel and Tourism Industry Management School, hereinafter referred to as I-TIM.

WHEREAS, I-TIM AND CONCORD recognize a common interest in international education; and


WHEREAS, I-TIM desires to make international study opportunities available to its students in the field of Hotel and Tourism Management, Park-Resort Management, and others;

WHEREAS, I-TIM and CONCORD further desire to cooperate in establishing a continuing educational relationship for the benefit of the respective students of each;


NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual consonances and agreements hereinafter set forth, the parties agree as follows:

- 1) I-TIM shall annually, or often, recommend CONCORD to its students interested in pursuing studies in the United States and shall make appropriate recommendations to CONCORD respecting the acceptance of such students. CONCORD agrees to accept such students from I-TIM, provided that such students are recommended by I-TIM, and shall have completed not less than one year of studies at I-TIM. CONCORD agrees to accept the credits earned at I-TIM in accordance with established college policies governing the acceptance of such transfer credits. Such transfer students from I-TIM who enroll at CONCORD, pursuant to the terms of this Agreement, shall make payment directly to CONCORD of the number of students desiring to transfer to CONCORD, for current room, board and other fees. I-TIM shall inform CONCORD of the number of students desiring to transfer to CONCORD at least four months prior to the beginning of the academic year.
- 2) I-TIM agrees to supply as soon as possible final letter grades and other essential academic records to CONCORD, OFFICE OF THE REGISTRAR, for all I-TIM students who study at CONCORD during the provision of

- 3) The collection and processing of admission applications to CONCORD, pursuant to this agreement, shall be the responsibility of I-TIM. I-TIM shall forward to CONCORD a group application including therein copies of each completed application of the individual candidates, together with transcripts and any other appropriate academic records. It shall not be necessary that individual recommendations of the candidates be forwarded to CONCORD. There shall be no application fee required to be paid to CONCORD By I-TIM and/or the respective candidates for admission to CONCORD.
- 4) I-TIM students participating in this program shall make and required payments for tuition, room, board or other fees connected with the program directly to CONCORD. Such students shall consider a full-time student at CONCORD, PURSUANT TO THE TERMS HEREOF. Such students shall be accorded all the rights and privileges of regular students at CONCORD.
- 5) The terms of this Agreement shall begin on the date hereof and shall continue thereafter unless terminated. This Agreement may be terminated by either party by giving the other party prior written notice of one (1) year prior to the termination thereof.
- 6) It shall be the intent of each party hereto to exercise every good faith effort to promote the aims and objectives of the program.

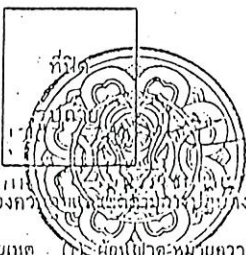
