## MATHEMATICS and ENGLISH PLACEMENT GUIDE

## 1.MATHEMATICS PLACEMENT

The minimum test scores required for course placement are as follows:

Students who have successfully completed any mathematics course 100 level or above may enroll in MATH 101, 103, or 105 regardless of test scores.

Equivalent Proficiency for MATH 103 and 104: Students who achieved a mathematics ACT score of 25 or higher (or SAT of 580 or higher) may have MATH 103 waived as a course prerequisite and as a program requirement for degrees in science and mathematics. Students who achieved a mathematics ACT score of 28 or higher (or SAT of 630 or higher) may also have MATH 104 waived as a course prerequisite and program requirement for degrees in science and mathematics.

PLACEMENT IN ENGLISH 102: Students who have taken either of the AP English Exams and achieved a score of 3 or better will receive credit for ENGL 101 and should be placed in 102.

Students who have an ACT of 25/SAT 1210 or above in English have the option of taking the English 101 Proficiency Test, administered by the Department of Humanities. This test may be taken in the Department office at any time, although students should allow at least one hour to complete it. Students who demonstrate a mastery of the skills taught in ENGL 101 will be eligible for placement in ENGL 102.

The West Virginia General Summative Assessment achievement level score of Level $\mathbf{3}$ in Mathematics or the English is eligible for placement in courses without corequisite support in that content area.
