HELPFUL HINTS

RNs interested in completing the BSN program must:

- ✓ Hold a valid RN license
- ✓ Have earned an Associate's Degree in Nursing
- ✓ Submit a formal application to the BSN program
- ✓ Have at least a 2.5 GPA upon entry
- ✓ Maintain a 3.0 GPA in Nursing classes taken at Concord
- ✓ Earn 120 total credit hours to graduate (36 credit hours must be completed at Concord)
